



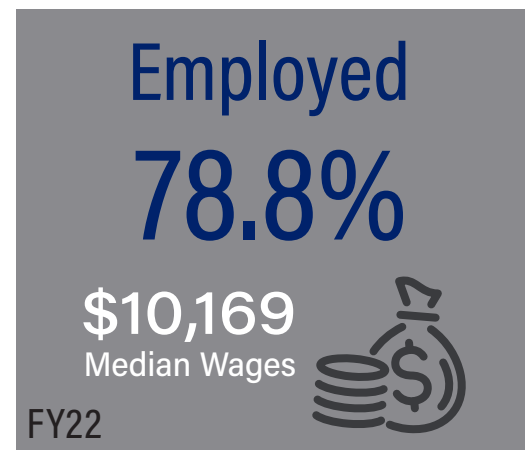
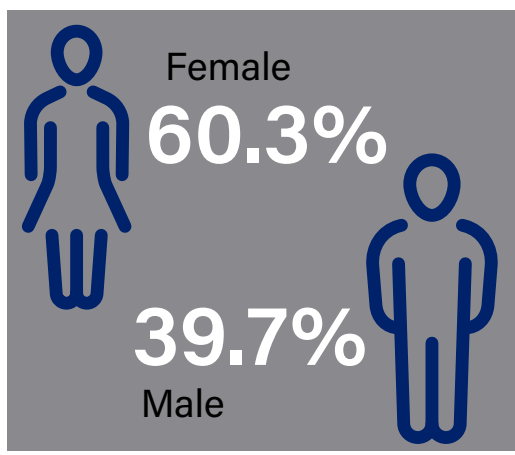
WORK READY DUAL CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP

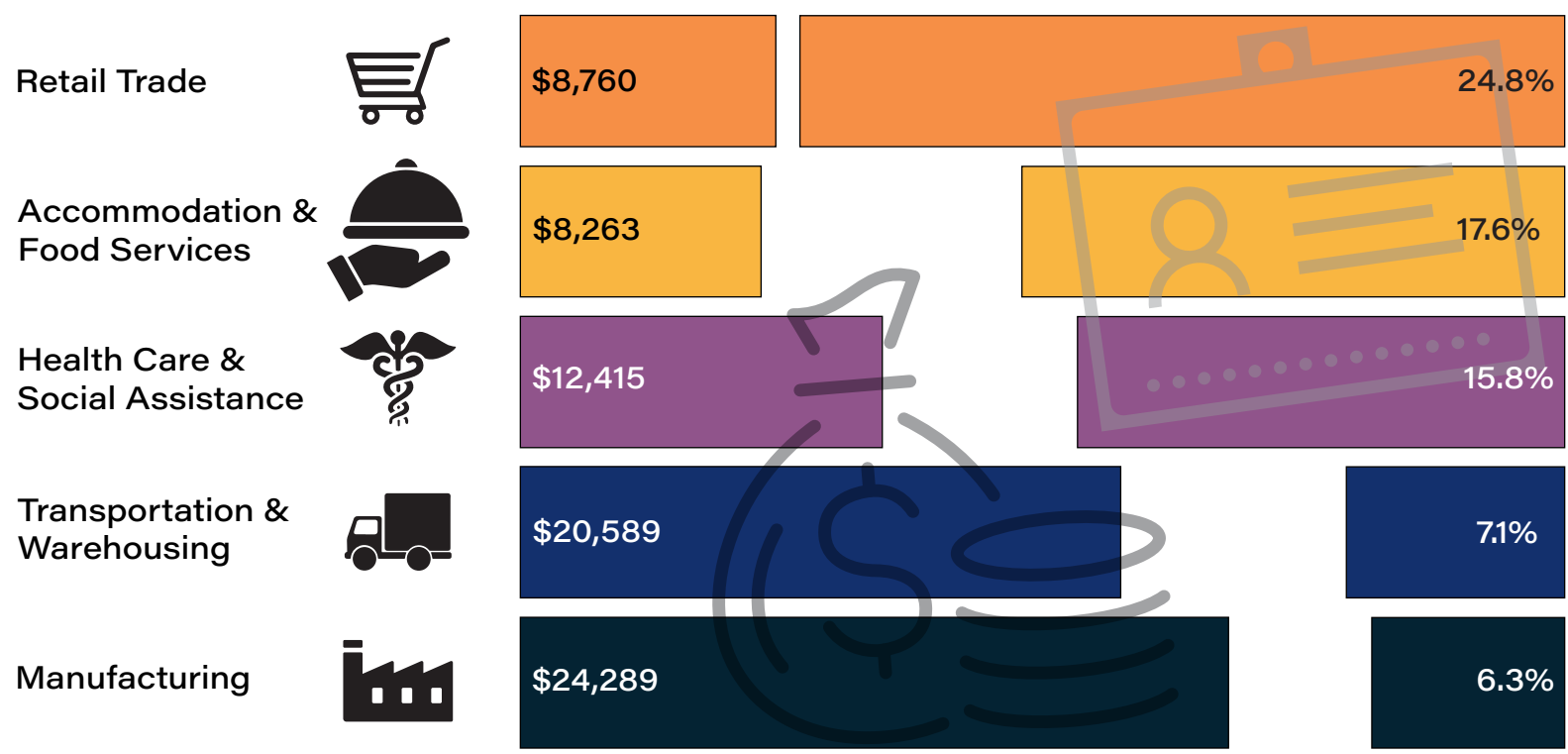
The Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship Program (WKDC), a portion of WRKS, provides aid to high school students to pursue dual credit in a similarly eligible postsecondary course. These metrics reflect the 2021 high school graduates who were recipients of WKDC scholarship.

High school students who received a Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship, one year after graduation.



All high school students, one year after graduation.

Over **93%** of WKDC high school graduates were **employed or enrolled** one year after graduation

WKDC high school graduates who were **employed but did not enroll** in postsecondary, earned a median wage of **\$18,154**

Over **85%** of all high school graduates were **employed or enrolled** one year after graduation

All high school graduates who were **employed but did not enroll** in postsecondary, earned a median wage of **\$14,948**

Enrollment Summary for Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship Students:

After high school graduation, 70% of students were enrolled in a college.

Among those students, 28 median credit hours were attempted.

There were 24 median credit hours actually earned.

The median first year college GPA was 3.03.
