


WORK READY DUAL CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP

2021



The Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship Program (WKDC), a portion of WRKS, provides aid to high school students to pursue dual credit in a similarly eligible postsecondary course. These metrics reflect the 2021 high school graduates who were recipients of WKDC scholarship.

Of HS Graduates who Received a Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship:








Top Industries

WKDC high school graduates who were *employed but did not enroll* in postsecondary, earned a median wage of \$18,154

Over **85%** of all high school graduates were *employed* or *enrolled* one year after graduation

All high school graduates who were *employed* but did not enroll in postsecondary, earned a median wage of \$14,948

Enrollment Summary for Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship Students:

After high school graduation, 70% of students were enrolled in a college.

Among those students, 28 median credit hours were attempted.

There were 24 median credit hours actually earned.

The median first year college GPA was 3.03.
