

# Kentucky High School Feedback Report on College Success

The Kentucky High School Feedback Report is produced by the Kentucky Center for Education and Workforce Statistics utilizing data from the Kentucky Longitudinal Data System (KLDs), which includes data from the Kentucky Department of Education, Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education, and the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority. This report provides the most complete and accurate data about college success that exists for this school. It follows students who graduated from public high schools in 2010-11 and were enrolled at an in-state public college or university during the 2011-12 academic year.

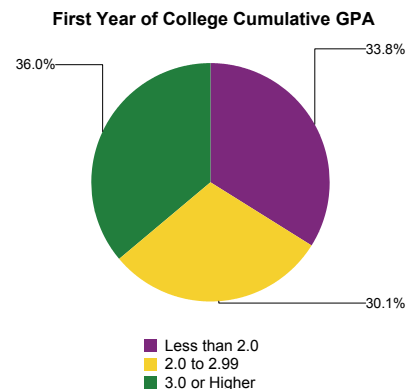

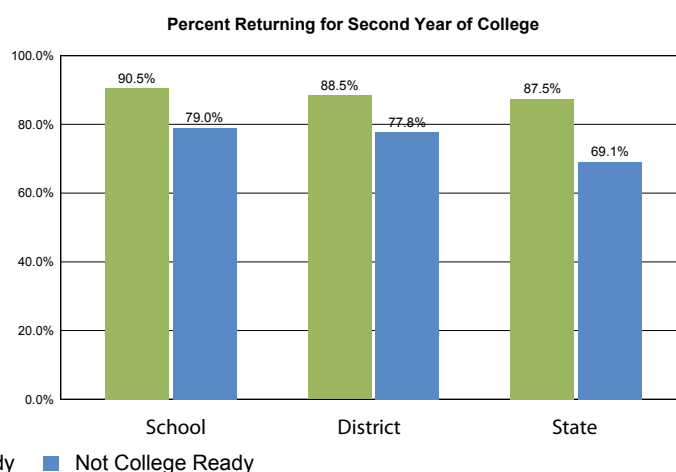

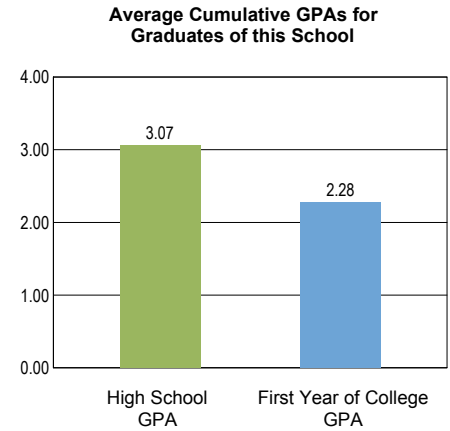

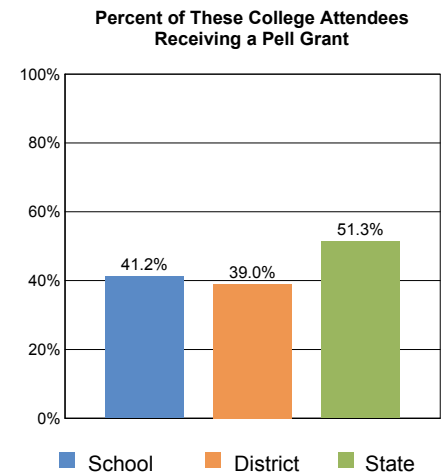

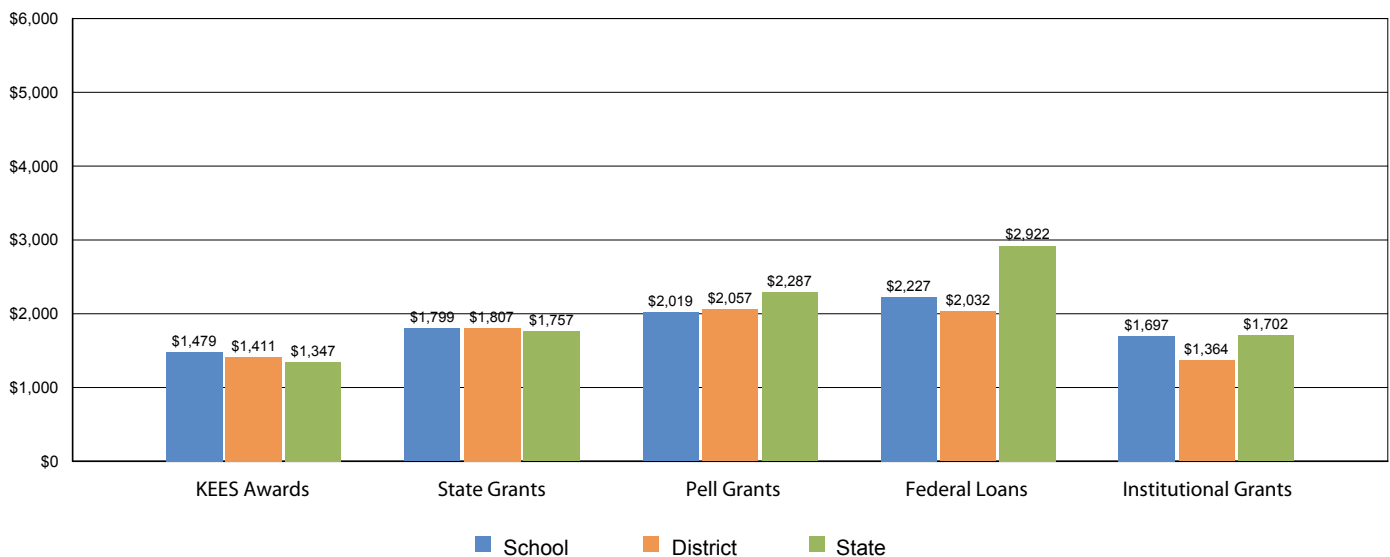

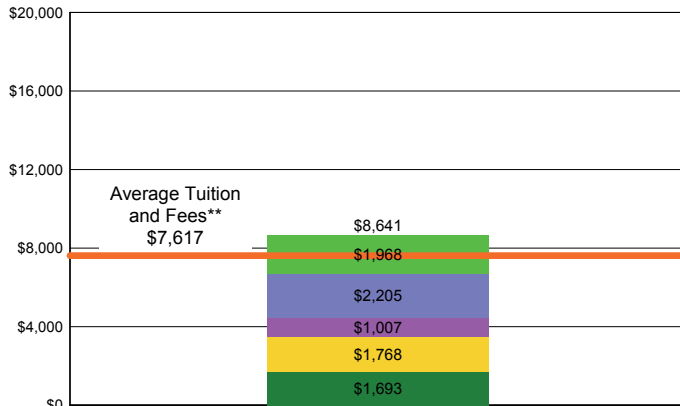

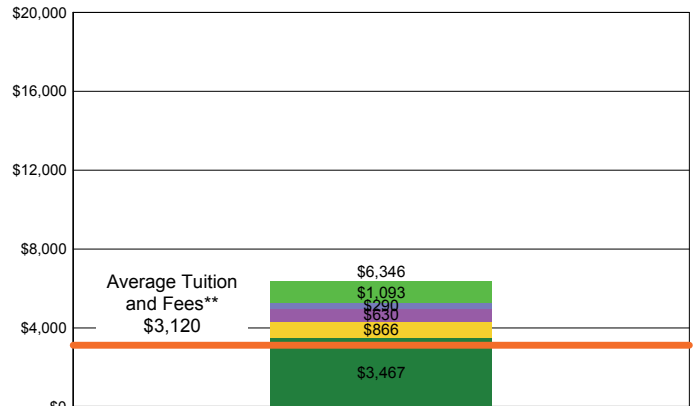
**Average Per Student Financial Aid Award by Type**

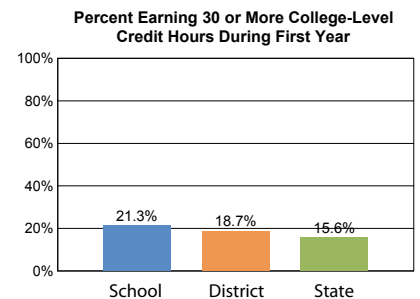

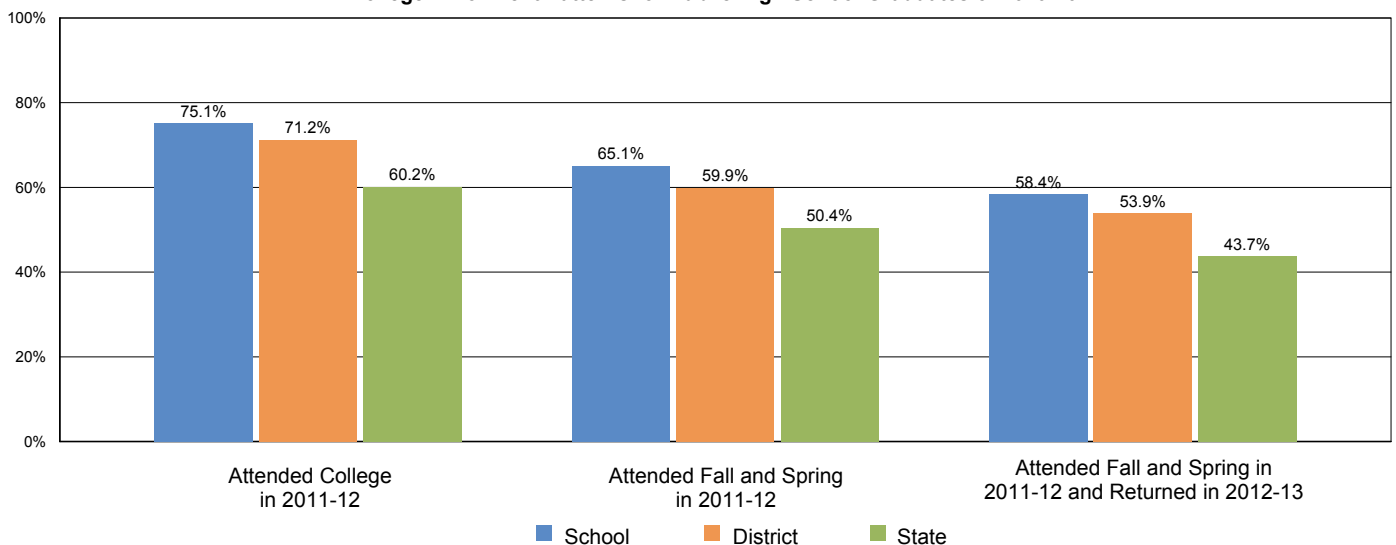
