The Kentucky High School Feedback Report is produced by the Kentucky Center for Statistics (KYSTATS) utilizing data from the Kentucky Longitudinal Data System (KLDS), which includes data from the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE), the Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE), and the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority (KHEAA). This report provides the most complete and accurate data about college-going and first year success that exists for this school. It provides data on students who graduated from public high schools in 2022-23 and were enrolled at an in-state college or university during the 2023-24 academic year. **First year success looks at the subgroup of graduates who enrolled at an in-state public college or university only.**

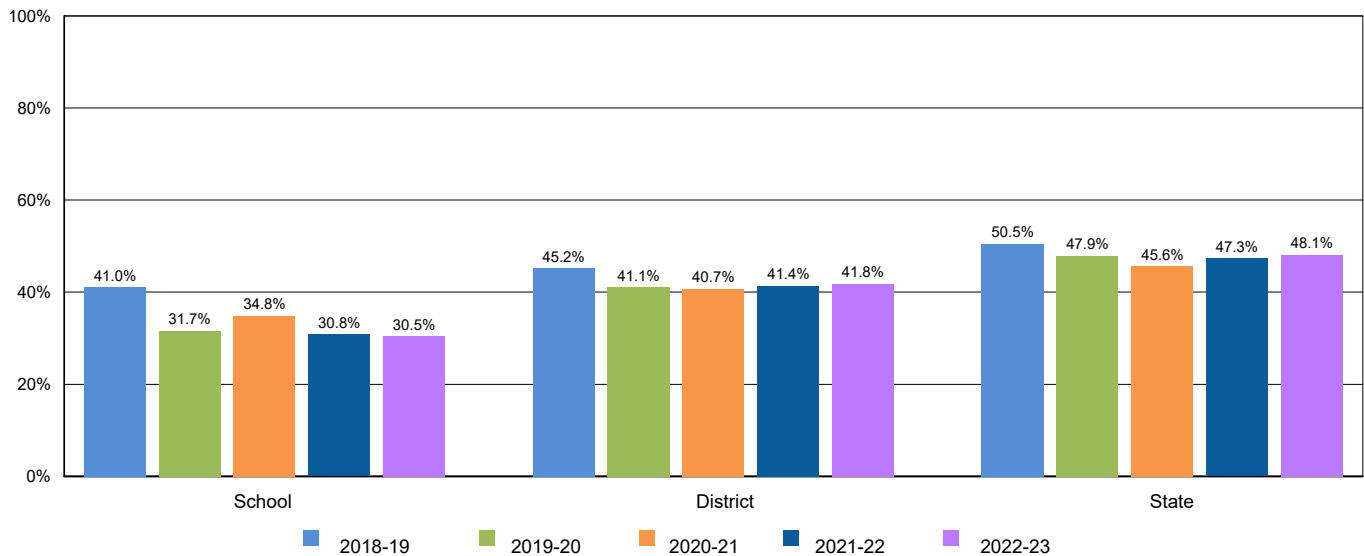

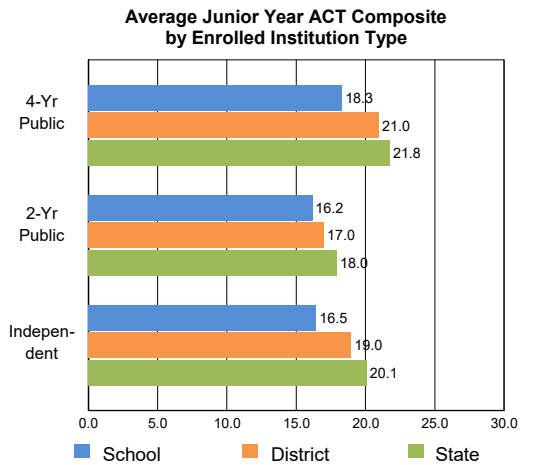
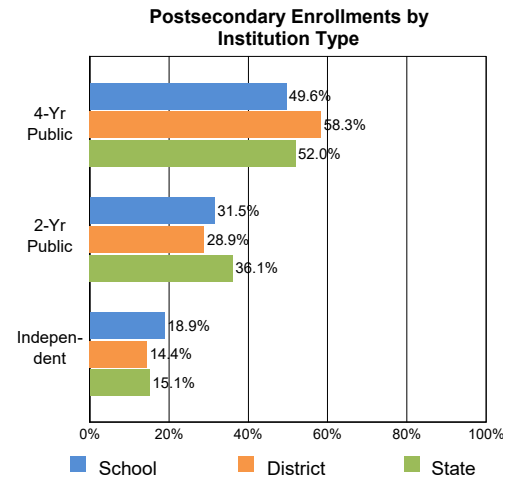
In-State College-Going Rates Compared to Previous Graduating Classes



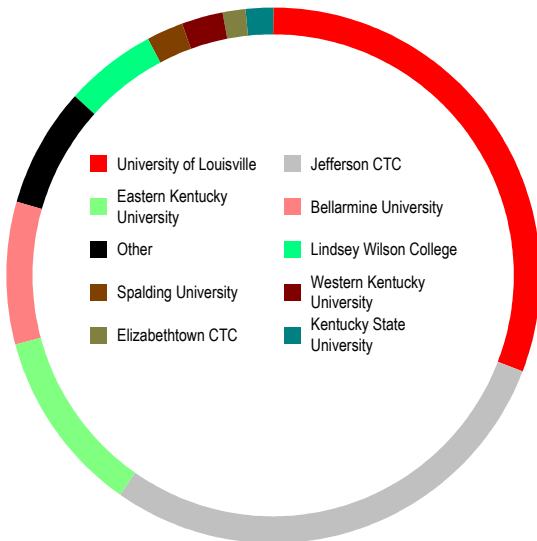

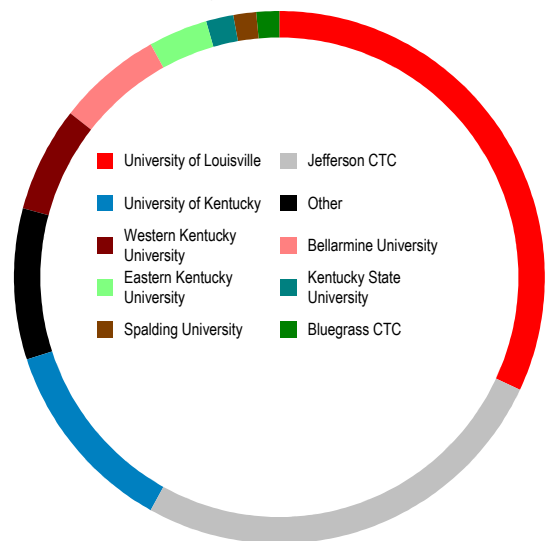

Top Postsecondary Institutions Attended by Graduates of this School



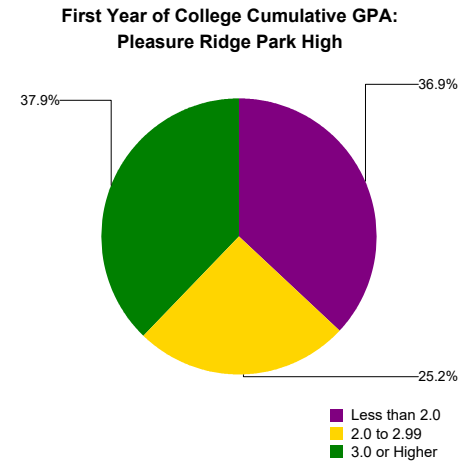
Top Postsecondary Institutions Attended by Graduates of this District



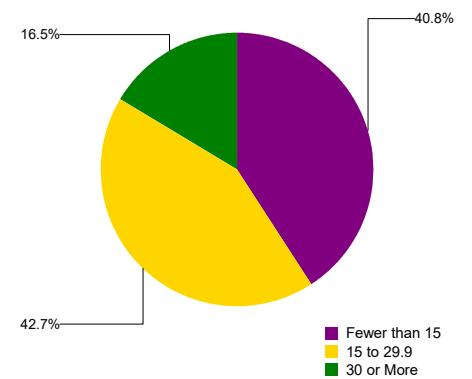

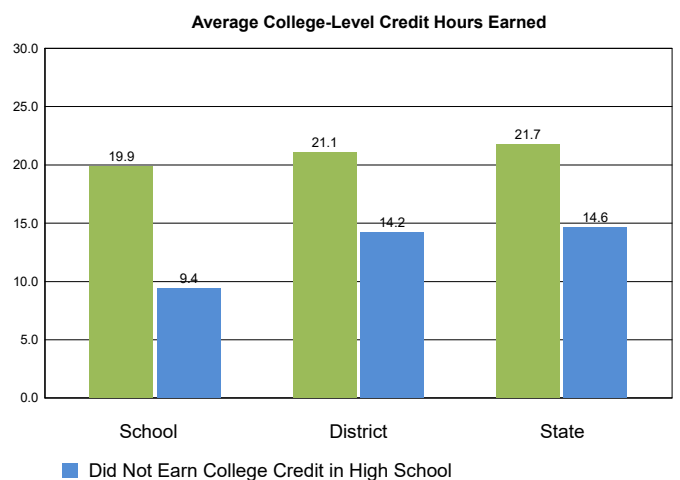
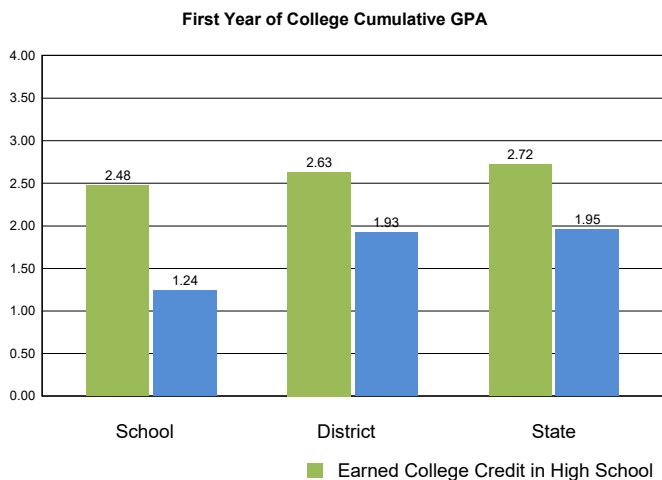
First Year of College Credit Hours Earned: Pleasure Ridge Park High

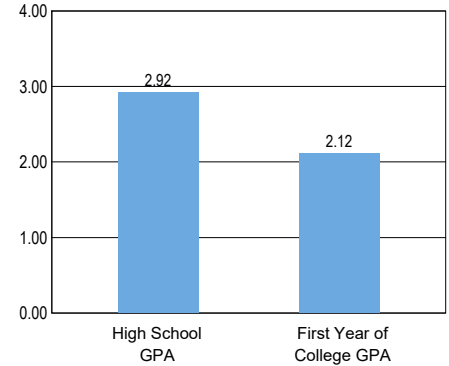
College Performance by Earning College Credit in High School

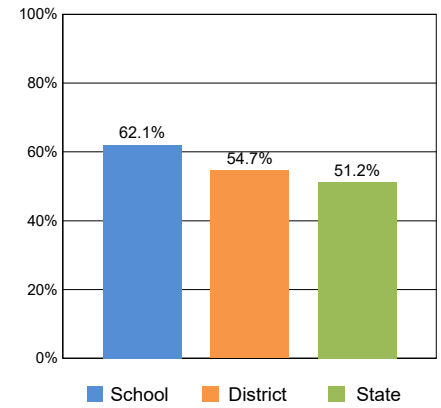
Average Cumulative GPA for Graduates of Pleasure Ridge Park High



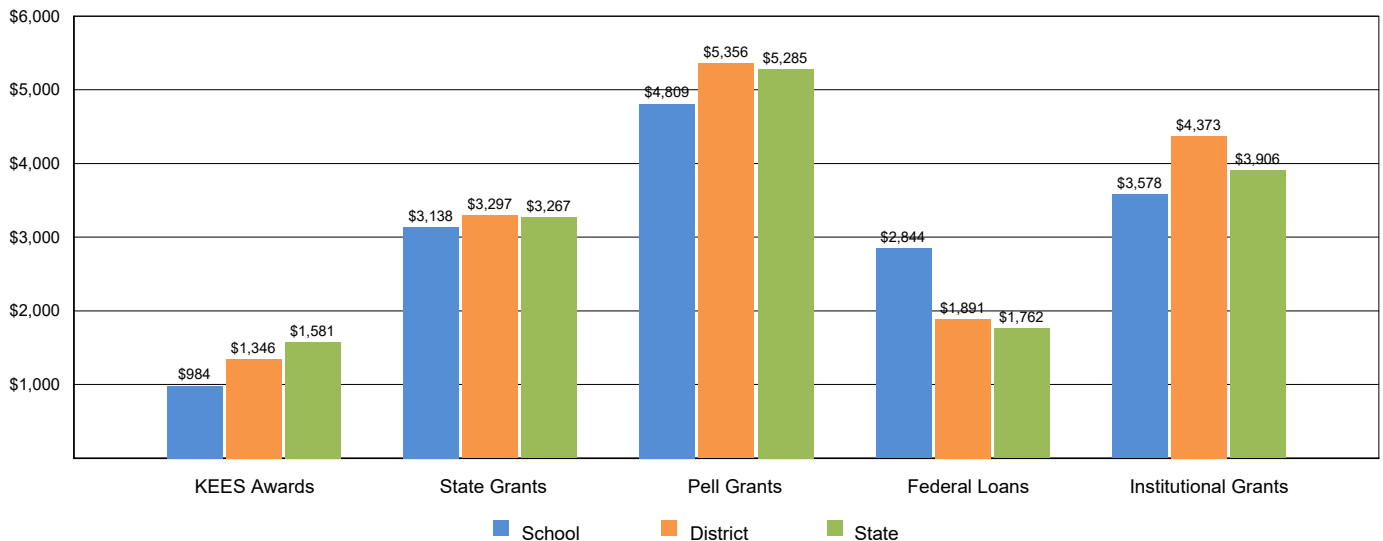
