


WORK READY DUAL CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP

Of HS Graduates who Received a Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship:








Top Industries

WKDC high school graduates who were *employed but did not enroll* in postsecondary, earned a median wage of \$17,079

Over **84%** of all high school graduates were *employed* or *enrolled* in postsecondary one year after graduation

All high school graduates who were *employed* but did not enroll in postsecondary, earned a median wage of \$14,846

In the First Year After High School for Work Ready Dual Credit Scholarship Students:

After high school graduation, 7,457 students were enrolled in a college.

Among those students, a median of 28 credit hours were attempted.

There was a median of 24 credit hours earned.

The median first year college GPA was 3.00.
